Pedestrian Hit and Run Investigation

The operator of an unknown vehicle remains at large after striking a pedestrian during the early evening hours of February 28, 2017.

On February 28, 2017, Salisbury Police Officers responded to the intersection of Rt 50 and Truitt Street for a reported pedestrian hit and run motor vehicle collision. Officers arrived on scene and quickly located the 14-year-old male victim laying in the roadway. Salisbury emergency medical personnel responded to the scene and transported the victim to Peninsula Regional Medical Center where he was treated and released for serious injuries to his lower extremities.

Further investigation revealed that the victim was walking north across Rt 50 in the area of Truitt Street. The suspect vehicle was traveling west on Rt 50. As the victim tried to cross the west bound lanes of Rt 50, he was struck by the suspect vehicle.

The investigation is on-going and the Salisbury Police Department is actively working to identify the suspect vehicle as well as the operator.
